## Quick Notes

\* Please park vehicles in your driveway. Your CCR's specify that vehicles are to be parked in garages. Exceptions have been made over the years to allow for parking in the driveway, however parking in the street should be limited to special situations or events, as it creates a hazard for motorist and pedestrians.

\* Are golf carts or ATVs allowed on common grounds? On pavement only.

\* Can I paint my home's brick? No, this is not permissible, per our Architectural Controls. See our website or your closing documents for details.

\* Who can use our pool, tennis court, or other amenities? Redwing Meadows residents only, unless accompanied by a resident.
